

A long action interrupted by a shorter one:

'I <u>was swimming</u> in the lake when I <u>felt</u> a slimy touch.'

# Past perfect

To show that a past action happened BEFORE another past action:

To talk about events BEFORE the main story

I <u>felt</u> a slimy touch. I <u>looked</u> down and I <u>saw</u> that I <u>had swum</u> through a clump of water plants.


